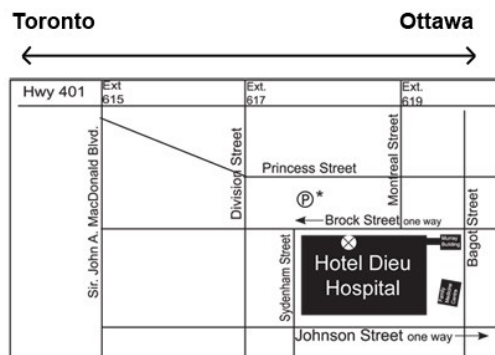

treatment of hand injuries; she is certified in somatosensory rehabilitation through the University of Brussels.
